## **Cornel Burzo**

The leading Romanian 6 Dan is one of the best European players, who provides highly regarded teaching lessons on many of the online Go Servers. Cornel has been Romanian champion on 2 occasions and has represented his country and Europe in many international tournaments, the most recent being the 2011 World Mind Sport Games and 2012 European Go Congress. He has competed in the World Amateur Championships on 6 occasions and has consistently achieved a top ten position with his best result being 5<sup>th</sup> place.

### **Format**

The event will include a strategic overview of the game, review of common Joseki and “trick” moves and an opportunity for you to play against Cornel in simultaneous games. You will also have the opportunity to submit a game for offline review by Cornel using the KGS Go server.

In addition Cornel will lead a **free**, closed group teaching session at 20.00 hours on Monday March 25<sup>th</sup> 2013 for event participants only, on the KGS Go server.

### **Entry Fee**

The fee for participating in the event is £17.50 which will include a buffet style lunch together with coffee and tea.

### **Location**
