

Northern Go Tournament

The Northern Go Tournament is taking place again this year on Saturday 28th November at Cheadle Hulme School, Claremont Road, Cheadle Hulme, Stockport, SK8 6EF.

No food will be provided, and it is suggested that you bring your own sandwiches. However, there is a Co-op about a 10 minute walk from the school.

Coffee, tea, fruit juice and biscuits will be provided free during the day.

This will be a three-round McMahon tournament, with Fischer timing of 30 minutes' main time, plus 10 extra seconds per move (Class B). BGA rules apply. Komi is 7.5 points.

There will also be a self-pairing 13x13 handicap tournament as a side event.

Where to park

It's simple to park in a wrong car park, and it's almost impossible to get a phone signal.

There is plenty of free parking at the venue, however, please park at the **correct** car park, which is accessed via Claremont Road. Enter Claremont Road from Hulme Hall Road (the B5095).

Once on Claremont Road, go past the first car park, then turn left just before the railway bridge. Go through the school gates to the main building car park, and park anywhere. Walk up the steps, through the large green door, past Reception and follow the Go signs to the 'UnderPass'. (It's the same venue, car park and playing room as last year.)
