## British Open Pair Go Championship Saturday 10th June 2023

When: Enter by 18:00 on 9th June by email to Patrick Ridley at <u>p.a.ridley@gmail.com</u>; register between 10:30 and 11:00 am on Saturday 10th June.

Where: This year, the Championship will be held at Frodsham Community Centre, Fluin Lane, Frodsham, Cheshire, WA6 7QN. See <a href="https://centre.frodcomm.org.uk/">https://centre.frodcomm.org.uk/</a>. There are good railway connections to Frodsham and Frodsham Station is 5 minute's walk from the Community Centre. If you are travelling by car, Frodsham is close to the M56 motorway. From M56 junction 12 follow the signs for Frodsham. At the traffic lights cross the swing bridge over the River Weaver. You will then be on Sutton Causeway leading to Bridge Lane. Continue for 800 yards passed the zebra crossing and under the pedestrian footbridge then turn left into Fluin lane. The Centre is about 200 metres up Fluin Lane, on the right-hand side and has plentiful parking.

**Format:** We play a three-round Swiss system tournament with Japanese (not BGA) rules; time limits will be 45 minutes, sudden death; komi where needed will be 6.5 points.

There are two divisions; even game and handicap. The grade of a pair is the average grade of the players in the pair. The even game section is for the eight highest-graded pairs. It is open to all, but only BGA members who are eligible for selection as representative players will be awarded points towards representing the BGA in the International Amateur or European Pair Go Championships. All others play in the handicap section on handicaps based on entry grades.
