

British Pair Go Championship 2025

Nottingham - Saturday 14 June 2025

Please join us for the British Pair Go Championship in Nottingham. Pair Go is played by a male and female partnership, with both partners taking turns to play the moves (without conferring). Due to the partnership element of this event, it is a very convivial and friendly tournament welcoming partnerships of all grades and grade mixes.

This event decides the British Pair Go Champions for the year and also the top 'handicap' section pair (based on number of wins).

The event is open to any male and female partnerships. As the event also helps the British Go Association select pairs to represent the UK in the International Amateur Pair Go Championship we will require nationality information for those pairs in the upper end of the event. The top eight all British pairs in the event gain points towards selection for that event.

This year we are changing the format of the event to run all pairs in one section. The top group of eight starting above the bar will in effect play off for the title. All other pairs will be started in the handicap section and will play full handicap games. There may be some fluidity between pairs in the top group and the handicap section in the latter two rounds if there are closely graded pairs between the sections.
