#### **British Go Championship**

The title Match was played at the Mind Sports Olympiad. The challenger Young Kim played the reigning champion Matthew Macfadyen for best-offive. Matthew won the match 3 games to 1 so only four games were required, but congratulations too to Young Kim, who is the only person to win a game against Matthew in the title match in the last five years.

#### Northern, Manchester, 1st - 2nd September

55 players attended the Northern. T.Mark Hall (4 dan) was the winner with 5 wins and a jigo (draw). Second was Huddersfield's Min Yang (4 dan) with 5 and third was Piers Shepperson (5 dan) with 4.5. Next placed on 4 wins were David Ward (4 dan Cambridge), Ruud Stoelman (2 dan Bradford), Andrew Morris (1 kyu Lancaster) and Mike Cockburn (1 kyu St Albans). On 5/6 was Steve Bailey (3 kyu West Surrey) and 6/6 was Philip Ackland-Ward (8 kyu Barmouth). Martin Cook (10 kyu York) was the best double figure kyu with 4 wins

#### Milton Keynes, 16th September

63 players attended. Matthew Macfadyen (6 dan Leamington) was the winner with 3 out of 3 wins. Second was Francis Roads (4 dan Wanstead) and third Bill Brakes (3 dan Milton Keynes), both on 2 wins. Other players to win all 3 games were: Natasha Regan (1 kyu Epsom), Helen Harvey (1 kyu Manchester), Edward Blockley (2 kyu Worcester), Matthew Selby (3 kyu Epsom), Richard Mullens (5 kyu St Albans). The side-event was unusual and interesting. This was Go played on a map of Milton Keynes.

#### Penzance, 29th - 30th September

Winner of the Lightning Handicap was Roger Daniel (2k London) who won 4 out of 5 games. 2nd was Eddie Smithers (1d Leicester) also with 4 wins. Toby Manning (3d Learnington) and Tig Deal (14k West Cornwall) tied for 3rd place with 3½ wins.

Main Tournament, 22 players. 1st was Alistair Wall (4 dan Wanstead) who won all 3 games. Tim Varley (12 k West Cornwall) also won 3 games, and Jake Finnis (17 kyu West Cornwall) won 21/2.
